Dear students, parents and carers,

### Y11 Pre-Public Exams (PPEs)

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## **Exam Start and End Date/Exam Timetables**

This year, the exam season will start on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May and will finish on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June (with a contingency day on 26<sup>th</sup> June).

Students personalised timetables will be published at the start of next term through Bromcom, issued on paper by tutors, as well as posted to parents/carers. Finalised seats and rooms will follow later in Term 4.

Before each exam, we will support students through an exam briefing in the main hall, making students' continued, punctual attendance important. Your support in making sure each student arrives in school having had breakfast, so they are fuelled for the day, also, makes a huge difference.

### Celebration Day, Friday 24th May

We plan to hold our celebration day for students on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May, which will include a final celebration assembly for the year group, which includes an invitation to all Year 11 parents/carers. Further details and timings will be sent out in due course. It is worth noting that students should not see this as their 'last day', as they will still have the second half of the exam season to complete.

#### Study Leave

We expect all students to maintain full school attendance throughout the course of Year 11. However, during Term 6, we accept that a small number of students may wish to revise at home. Where this is the case, we will send out a link to parents during Term 5 to receive requests for study leave. Students will only be granted study leave if this request is submitted.

Throughout the course of the exam season, we will continue to run our school timetable, and support students' revision. Students are expected to attend school in full uniform throughout the exam season.

On exam days themselves, we will take a sensible approach, where students will be given space to revise for an exam they have later that day. Otherwise, we expect students to engage with their timetabled teachers, in order to make final preparations for their remaining exams.

We look forward to celebrating with Year 11 students, on the completion of the exam season later this year. We would like to remind all Year 11 students that this is an invite only event and that, in order to receive an invite, we expect students to maintain a high level of effort, conduct and the best possible attendance.







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# GCSE Results Day, Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August

We will make GCSE results available to students from 8am through Bromcom, and open the school for students to collect their results' statements from 8:30am. Official exam certificates are not received from the exam boards until the autumn. On this day, the exams team will be available to support with enquiries, as well as Tina Belcher, our careers advisor, should further advice be required about post-16 pathways.
