## **Reminders Regarding Year 11**

After some time in their form groups, we will have their Leaver's Celebration Assembly, followed by lunch and social time together for the signing of shirts and taking of photos etc. Please support us in ensuring your child does **not engage in shirt signing until after the Celebration Assembly has occurred** – they are expected to be in correct and full school uniform for this. The day will end at 3:10 and students will be able to travel home as normal.

We would very much like to invite all parents and carers to join us for the Celebration Assembly. **This will run from 12:30 until roughly 1:30 and take place in the Leisure Centre.** This will involve a short speech from their tutors, their Year Coordinator and members of the Senior Leadership Team.
